

ORDINANCE NO. BH: 2008-1 Revised Fee Schedule

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANVILLE BOARD OF HEALTH CONSOLIDATING AND ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR HEALTH DEPARTMENT SERVICES".

SECTION I. An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance of the Borough of Manville Board of Health Consolidating and Establishing A Fee Schedule for Health Department Services" is hereby enacted by the Manville Board of Health.

SECTION II. Fee Schedule.

The following fees shall be paid before service is rendered:

1. Retail food establishment (annual fee):	\$100.00	\$200.00

8. Vending machines permit: Limited Service:	\$ 20.00 + \$5.00	\$ 20.00+\$10/unit

9. Temporary food sale permit:	\$ 30.00	\$ 50.00
10. Mobile food vendor (annual fee):	\$ 50.00	\$100.00
11. Milk license: Wholesale:	\$ 50.00	\$100.00
Retail:	\$ 25.00	\$ 25.00
12. If a food establishment has been closed for 21 consecutive days or more, a reinspection is required prior to reopening.		
13. No person shall conduct, maintain or operate a public eating establishment in the Borough of Manville who does not successfully complete a course in food handling acceptable to Health Officer or other designated agent of the Board of Health. Training must be completed at a frequency consistent with the following:		

- A) At least one (1) establishment manager must be certified in an acceptable course in food sanitation at least once every five (5) years.
- B) Any proposed establishment which files an application to operate a public eating establishment must complete an acceptable course within one (1) year of operation.
- C) Any establishment which receives a below satisfactory inspection

SECTION III. If any section of this ordinance shall be found unconstitutional, the other sections shall not be affected.

SECTION IV. Violations and Penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$5,000 or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each violation of any of the provisions of this chapter and each day the same is violated shall be deemed and taken to be a separate and distinct offense. Action may be brought in Municipal Court or any other court with jurisdiction.
