Ordinance #773 (continued)

4. Section XIII of Ordinance No. 741 is amended by adding thereto a paragraph c to read as follows:

“c. Except as otherwise specifically provided in Ordinance No. 741 and any amendments thereto from time to time adopted, no credit shall be allowed or appeal granted on a claim that water used has not been discharged into the sewer system.”

5. Section XVII of Ordinance No. 741 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION XVII. SWIMMING POOLS

A residential user on premises on which a swimming pool is located may register any such pool with the Borough on a written form provided through the Water/Sewer Department. Such form shall be signed by the user and shall include the tax lot and block number of the property upon which the pool is located, the water/sewer account number, the name and address of the user, the estimated water volume capacity of the pool, and a consent by the user for the Borough to enter upon the property during normal business hours for the purpose of inspecting and verifying the water volume capacity of the pool.

1. A user who after registering a pool as herein provided and upon seven (7) days written notice to the Water/Sewer Department of the date upon which the user's empty pool is to be completely filled, shall upon verification, receive credit equivalent to one hundred (100%) percent of the water volume capacity of the pool against water used for purposes of calculating that year's annual residential sewer user charge.

2. A user who, after registering a pool as herein provided, does not fill the pool in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Section, shall, upon verification, receive credit equivalent to fifty (50%) percent of the water volume capacity of the pool against water used for purposes of calculating that year's annual residential sewer user charge.

3. No user shall be entitled, in any one year, to more than a single credit under either paragraph 1 and/or 2 of this Section.

4. No other credits shall be allowed for water usage attributable to residential swimming pools.

5. No person shall discharge, cause, permit or allow any water from a swimming pool to be discharged into the sanitary sewer system.

6. In the event that any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance which may be given effect, and to realize this intent, the provisions and applications of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

7. Should any provision of this ordinance be inconsistent with the provisions of any prior ordinances, the inconsistent provisions of prior ordinances are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.
