Dear New Jersey American Water Customer:

New Jersey American Water is committed to providing high-quality, reliable water service to our customers. This requires continually investing in our distribution system. One of these distribution system improvements is scheduled to take place in your area.

Beginning the week of August 2, 2010 CRJ Contracting Co. Inc. a contractor for, New Jersey American Water will be replacing approximately 3,500 feet of 8" water main along Brooks Boulevard from South Main Street to North Thirteenth Avenue. This project will improve the reliability of water service to the area.

For the safety of our employees and our authorized contractors, road closures will be necessary between 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Some portions of the installation could be scheduled for evening hours between 8:00PM and 6:00 AM in the vicinity of Thirteenth Avenue and Brooks Boulevard and South Main Street and First Avenue. Be assured that our crews will be working as quickly and diligently as possible to complete this important improvement to our distribution system. Should you require access to your property during the hours of construction, please notify one of the traffic control officers stationed at both ends of the construction zone, and use extra caution and obey all traffic signs. All traffic detours and road closures will be coordinated by the Manville Borough Police Department.

Weather permitting; installation of the pipeline should be completed by the end of September. This will enable Manville Borough to schedule the Brooks Boulevard resurfacing project for October 2010.
